


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Just What Are Websites Anyway?

Web sites have become the common calling card of companies worldwide.



There are online shopping malls, auction sites, bookstores, videograms, and sites like MySpace, FaceBook and Twitter are the standard fare these days. Just What Are Websites Anyway?



Websites are boxes with lots of stuff inside. How people find what's in it is up to you.

A **website** is one big box with a bunch of stuff inside. It can be just about any size but we'll focus on the most common size used by over 90% of the people in the world.

Outside the box is the cover, or packaging. It's the first page you see when you come to a website, and should not only identify the contents of the box, but resemble what's inside in some way.


The way people will find your website is called an address, and that address can be just about anything.

Although there are other ways of naming your start page, we'll focus on the basic "index" name, and work our way up from there.

There are five lines of code that start every website "I" design. This keeps it simple, and does exactly what I need it to do.

A **grid** is where you're going to place your text, pictures, menus, links, video, animation, slideshow, etc.

The size of your website will be determined by the standards most sites are using today.

In the past, programmers were forced to design sites based on different screen sizes of the people viewing the site, but because that is not a good way to make it happen, new standards have emerged for just placing content in the center, at a base size, and leaving it at that.

That way, all the various browsers will most likely show the site the same way. For the purpose of programming your own site, let's change your screen size to something else, and then we'll discuss the grid.


